This Union Notes;

That there is currently no formalised structure for a part time executive officer to report to council on the work that they do.

This Union Believes;

The work of the executive, full time and part, is vital and integral to a the democratic, representative nature of the Union

That the reporting to council from the sabbatical officers is a key element in the BSU structure to ensure that the full time sabbatical officers are working to the values, beliefs, aims and policies of the Union.

That the part time officers current and anticipated work is of interest to the student body and council

That the Part time officers should be given the opportunity to report to council on there work

That council should be given the opportunity to hold the executive committee as a whole and it's individual members to account.

This Union Mandates;

That Part time officers provide a summary of the work they have undertaken for each Union council

That this the reporting be made part of the job description of the part time faculty officer therefore amending the text of the constitution

The first reports to be available for the March 2005 council

That the reports should highlight the work that they have undertaken for the Student Union e.g. campaigns work.

The reports should also report back to council on the faculty boards that the officer may have attended during the period between councils
