



## **Quality of Student Life at the Chalfont Campus**

### **This Union believes;**

That Students based at Chalfont have a right to the same facilities and services as presented to those studying in High Wycombe

That despite the background efforts of BCSU, Students judge the Students' Union on what is visible to them – presence of Staff and Officers on Campus, regular events and entertainments, support of Student Activities, trips, etc.

That Students' feel aggrieved at the obvious differences in service levels between High Wycombe and Chalfont Campuses – both BNU and BSU

That there is a clear need for social activities at Chalfont, as well as an acceptable standard of transport, allowing access to activities off-campus.

That Chalfont Students are well aware that most BNU services and Departments are centralised around the HW Campus.

That despite the drastic improvement of Transport to and from the Chalfont Campus, the service is still in need of improvement.

That the Chalfont Campus has been visibly neglected by elected officers (past and present), which has damaged the SU's reputation with students.

### **This Union Recognises;**

That although it is difficult for individuals to maintain a weekly day and time they can be on campus, they should be able to divide their time and work effectively between campuses when not constrained by meeting locations.

That money should never be the first consideration in entertainments at the Chalfont Campus.

That a negative attitude towards the Students' Union within the Chalfont Student Community has been bred by a lack of visible presence, action, and attention on the behalf of SU Officers and Staff.

That the Chalfont Campus cannot sustain a healthy community without adequate transportation, facilities and activities.

### **This Union Resolves;**

To constantly monitor, and lobby to improve the transport services available at the Chalfont Campus, between the other campuses, and in the surrounding area.

To monitor the levels and quality of services offered at Chalfont by the University.

To thoroughly explore all possibilities for events to be staged at the Chalfont Campus, looking to minimise the financial risks to BSU, before disregarding them completely.

To assign one Chalfont-based Faculty Board each to the Vice President Student Involvement and Vice President Education and Welfare, to ensure their presence on Campus on a minimum of occasions.

To ensure that Officers and Union Staff are on-Campus as frequently as possible.

For Sabbatical Officers to identify (at least) one day where they will be available at the Chalfont Campus on a weekly basis. This should be done early-on in the term of office, and adhered to as far as possible.

To advertise (where possible) in advance when an Officer or Staff-member is due to be on campus, and do everything within our power to inform students of last-minute changes of plan.

To actively encourage student involvement in improving Campus life, through forums, advertising, and use of BSU Media.
